1.25 miles long, 212' above the Hudson. From the west side of the Hudson use Haviland Road off Rte 9W, just north of Mid Hudson Bridge intersection.

West side of the Hudson—Haviland Road off Rte 9W, just north of Mid Hudson Bridge intersection. Pass steep rock cuts & beautiful wetlands. Flora, fauna, & the occasional red eft (newt). All PAVED.

Enter Haviland, Commercial Ave, Near S. Chodikee Lake at Rotary Pavilion, or Tony Williams Park.
